HLTAID001 - Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

WHO SHOULD ENROL FOR THIS COURSE?

Participants who may be required to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in a range of situations in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) Guidelines, including community and workplace settings. This Course is essential for people who are required to be able to provide CPR if an emergency arises, learning the skills to recognise and manage a person who is unconscious and not breathing. CPR is able to sustain life until an ambulance arrives.

This training is suitable for both people in workplaces and members of the public.

- Assess casualties and recognise the need for CPR
- Perform CPR procedures in accordance with ARC Guidelines on adults and infants
- Display respectful behaviour
- Communicate details of a workplace injury, trauma and/or illness

WHO SHOULD ENROL FOR THIS COURSE?

Participants can include those who may be required to provide a first aid response to a casualty. This applies to all participants who may be required to provide First Aid response in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings. This Course is essential for people who are required to be able to provide first aid if an emergency situation arises during their employment, or everyday life.

This training is suitable for both people in workplaces and members of the public.

HLTAID004 - Provide an emergency first aid response in an education and care setting.

WHO SHOULD ENROL FOR THIS COURSE?

Participants who may be required to provide a first aid response to infants, children and adults. This Course applies to Educators and Support Staff working within an Education and Care setting who are required to respond to a first aid emergency, including asthmatic and anaphylactic emergencies.

The unit of Competency may contribute towards approved first aid, asthma and anaphylaxis training under the Education and Care Services National Law, and the Education and Care Services National Regulations (2011). This training is suitable for both people in workplaces and members of the public.

Course Accreditation – Provide First Aid – 3 Year Accreditation

The Safe Work Australia First Aid Model Code of Practice and Australian Resuscitation Council Guidelines (ARC) requires employers to ensure that their nominated first aiders attend training on a regular basis to remain current. Both the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) and the Safe Work Australia First Aid in the Workplace Code of Practice recommended First Aid training should be renewed every 3 years. However, the CPR component should be renewed every 12 months.

NOTE: It is important to note that the HLTAID competency standards do require a level of physical ability to meet the evidence requirements for assessment. These standards relate to the level of performance required to provide resuscitation and respond to an emergency situation where there may be risk to life.

Due to the potential risk to health and safety where a nominated first aider, or worker with duty of care, does not have the ability to perform resuscitation and/or first aid to the performance standard it is NOT appropriate to issue a Statement of Attainment to Candidates who are physically unable to meet the assessment requirements. EduNex alternatively will issue a Certificate of Attendance/Participation.

COURSE CERTIFICATE ISSUED

EduNex is a Registered Training Organisation (RTO 45283) and will be the RTO who is issuing your Nationally Recognised Training with a Statement of Attainment.

Note: For those Students who **DO NOT MEET** the unit requirements, a Certificate of Attendance/Participation will only be issued.

TRAINING METHOD

Delivery of this Course will be Trainer led, Face-to-face in a Classroom setting combined with Practical Assessments that provides realistic in-depth, scenarios and simulations to assess candidates' skills and knowledge. Classes are fun and face-to-face with plenty of practical hands on learning. Students are also required to complete Pre-Reading prior to course commencement.

COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Students must complete any required pre-reading prior to course commencement.
- Students must have the physical ability to provide resuscitation by kneeling on the floor and performing two (2) minutes of uninterrupted CPR.
- Students must be minimum of Eighteen (18) years of age.
- Students are required to complete a LLN Assessment via LLN Robot prior to course commencement
